Called to order by Georgia Cortez, President. Minutes of May board meeting read by Ellen Vandruff, secretary. Minutes approved as read by Cathy Otten, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Cheryl Hough, all approved.

#### Committee Reports:

Kathy Elsbury - Membership - 1 new member added in July. Membership is up to 60 members.

Cathy Otten - Programs - Cheryl Hough applique in August, Pam Myers quilt facing in September, Connie Polzin Christmas ornaments in November, December year-end celebration & gift exchange.

Cathy Otten - VP - Thinking about a new quilt challenge for 2025.

Cathy Otten - 2025 4 Corners Quilt Gathering - wallets are done - some need Velcro, collecting fat quarters for flower center pieces, collecting door prizes and working on coordinating businesses to focus on, also working on logging numbers for the member incentive program.

Cathy Otten - Talking to Malinda about the future of the Saturday meetings.

Cathy Otten - Hospitality - July potluck was a bust, hopefully August will be better. Discussion held among those in attendance about future solutions. #### County Fair Volunteers - Aug. 10th -18th


